

CampingF1 – Frequently Asked Questions

Are the prices on the website per person or per pitch/tent? All prices are per person.

What is the address of the campsite? Google Map links are available via the relevant website page.

What time can I check in? What time is Check out On Sunday & Monday? Check in is available from 08:00 each morning. Check out on Sunday is 21:00 in the evening and 12noon on Monday when the campsite closes.

When does the Campsite Open & Close? We are open from Wednesday 14:00 until Monday 12noon.

Can I bring my Pet? No

Can I park my car next to my tent? Yes

Can I just turn up and camp? No, we only offer pre-booked camping

Do you have Toilets and Showers on site? Yes and we do not charge you for using them.

Is there food on site? All sites either have a restaurant or catering on site. We can give you advice on supermarkets petrol stations & cash machines close to site at Campsite Reception.

What beds are included with the pre-erected tents? Single camping air beds.

Do you provide Sleeping Bags & Towels? In the interested of your hygiene and comfort we do not provide towels or bedding, you will need to bring your own. We can purchase from the UK a sleeping bag on your behalf and transport it to site for you. It is important you contact the office 6 weeks in advance for the relevant Grand Prix.

If I only book a pitch can I use the marquee? Yes, there are no restrictions to any part of our site, all prices include use and access to evening entertainment, bar, toilets and showers.

Do pre erected tent or pitches have electricity? No

Can I have electrical hook-up for my purpose built motor home or caravan? At most sites we can offer electrical hook-up to purpose built motorhomes & caravans. When available, spaces are very limited so early booking, up to 6 months in advanced is recommended, please call the office to book this.

Can I bring a generator? Yes, please ensure it is off before midnight.

Can I charge my phone/camera? Yes, ask at the bar. We have UK and Euro plugs, but don't forget your charger.

Can I use my hairdryer/ hair straighteners? Plug sockets can be provided in the marquee for this each morning.

Do you have anywhere secure for my valuables? Campingf1 is not responsible for any items damaged, lost or stolen from our site. Please do not bring any unnecessary valuables; we can keep small items eg. Passports secure for you if you do not have your own safe store.

Quite Time - Quite time is observed from 01:00 to 6:00am. We ask voices and noise must be kept to a minimum during these hours. All activities during this time should not interfere with the comfort and well-being of other campers.

What time does the coach leave campsite to go to the circuit? Times vary depending on venue & demand, generally 7:00am to 9:30am. A timetable will be available in Reception on the campsite.

What times does the coach return on Saturday & Sunday? Again, times vary depending on venue & demand, planned times are 16:00 to 18:30 on Saturday & 16:00 (or at race finish) to 18:30 on Sunday. A timetable will be available in Reception on the campsite.

Where can I pick up the coach at the circuit? Coaches pick up from where they dropped you off.

I am leaving immediately after the race on Sunday, can I check out in the morning but leave my car on site until after the race? Yes, please pack your things and see Reception staff in the morning.

At European events what currency does the CampingF1 bar accept? Euros & Sterling, but change will be given in Euros so we would recommend buying Euros in advance.

We are going to Germany but you ask for a £20 deposit, can we pay in Euros? Yes

Can I have a fire, fireworks and Chinese lanterns? No

Can I bring my own alcohol on site? Yes, but you are not permitted to drink it in the marquee and we ask that you do not bring glass bottles.

Can I smoke cigarettes on site? Yes, but NOT inside any Campingf1 structure. Naked flames (eg candles) are not allowed at all.
